

HOW WE HELP CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN OUR COMMUNITY

EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION CENTERS

Right Steps operates four public and one private Early Care and Education Centers in Greater Lafayette. Our centers provide quality early learning services for children between the ages of six weeks to six years old. All locations are state licensed and ranked Level 4 in Indiana's Paths to QUALITY rating system and accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children. Our privately operated center is owned by the Lafayette School Corporation and provides free child care to select Jefferson High School students to allow them an opportunity to obtain their diplomas. Right Steps offers a sliding fee scale and is eligible to receive child care vouchers to give access to families of all income levels.

AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Right Steps operates an after school enrichment program called Cool School at Miller and Vinton Elementary Schools in Lafayette. The after school enrichment program uses a curriculum incorporating the 40 developmental assets to support children's development. This program also offers a sliding fee scale.

CHILD AND ADULT FOOD PROGRAM

We are committed to supporting proper nutrition to boost optimal child development and combat childhood obesity. We utilize the Indiana Department of Education's Child and Adult Care Food Program. We extend this program to over 80 home child care providers in Tippecanoe and eight surrounding counties.

CHILD CARE RESOURCE AND REFERRAL

The Child Care Resource Network (TCCRN) provides resources and services to families such as free child care searches. TCCRN also serves child care providers and community partners in Tippecanoe and 11 surrounding counties.

QUICK FACTS

How often does the board meet?

- Our board meets eight times a year. Meetings are scheduled in advance for the year so you can add them to your calendar. We meet on the 4th Thursday of a scheduled month at 4pm.

Where does the board meet?

- We meet in the conference room located at our administrative office, 100 Saw Mill Road, Lafayette, IN 47909.

Are there membership dues?

- Yes, board member dues are \$50 per year.

How long is a membership term?

- Members serve a three-year term.
(May be elected to fill a position of less than three years or may be re-elected for an additional three-year term).

What are members expected to do?

- To actively serve on at least one committee.
- To assume board leadership responsibilities as requested and as possible (e.g. committee chair person, elected officer, etc.)
- To ensure that Right Steps operates within the adopted by-laws and legal requirements.
- To approve, monitor and evaluate Right Steps' policies and procedures and standards of organizational performance.
- To recruit new volunteers for the organization.
